These would be related to our Oliver and Sara, whom we bought in 1989 from Bonnie Peterson in Vermont. Sounded like good genes to me. Lark was the smallest in the litter and they called her Lil' Bit. It took her three times to pass the CGC as she refused to down on command (didn't like the facility were the class was held or the one outside or because it was Tuesday - who knows), passed the Beginner Novice and Rally Novice with no problems. She was working well on Tracking, Barn Hunt and Nose Work when I discovered a lump, August 2014. When it got bigger, samples of several tumors were sent in for testing. The Cancer was called Apocrine adenocarcinoma, sweat gland Cancer. It is such a rare, aggressive type that little is known about it. They don't know what causes it or where it comes from. No help to do Chemo because it is impossible to keep up with the growing tumors. In three months it was hard to get the pain pills down and she was having trouble eating. We miss her so much.
