TAKE THE LEAD

Have you heard of "Take The Lead" and wondered what it is? Take The Lead is a not-for-profit foundation under Section 501(c)3 of the IRS code. It started in 1993, as a brave response to the AIDS crisis which devastated many lives. Take The Lead's goal is to make a difference in the lives of those in the sport of dogs who suffer from a financial crisis during a life-threatening or terminal illnesses.

Take The Lead will pay medical services, insurance bills and any bill which is necessary to keep the recipient in their home. These services include home health workers or therapists, health insurance payments or deductible expenses, prescription drugs, transportation for health care, rent/mortgage payments, utilities and funeral expenses. The eligibility requirements are anyone who has made a serious commitment to the sport of dogs for at least five years and has a life-threatening or terminal illness. In addition, there must be a financial need. An application is available on the website.

While all assistance and requests for assistance are kept strictly confidential, it is safe to say that many members of the ATCA have been significantly helped by Take The Lead. More than 10's of thousands of dollars have gone to our ATCA members in crisis. In 2011, the ATCA became a sponsoring specialty club with yearly membership dues. Funds for Take The Lead are raised by ATCA at the Montgomery Specialty dinner silent auction and occasionally other fund raisers. The Donations and Disaster Relief Committee is responsible for raising Take The Lead funds.

Funds are raised for Take the Lead through membership in Take The Lead, direct tax deductible donations and fund raisers of all kinds by dog clubs across the country. A check made out to Take The Lead may be sent with your membership renewal to the ATCA treasurer. All contributions to Take The Lead are tax deductible to the full extent of the law.
